


Owl Mt Jeep Trail - 6.8 Miles



Access:

From the Junction of State Hwy 25 and US Hwy 395 travel west and then north on Hwy 395 18.7 miles. Turn left onto Little Boulder Creek Rd, (USFS 9576). Travel 5 miles. To your right is Kerry Creek Rd where the trail eventually comes out. Travel 1 more mile on Rd 9576 to Grouse Mt Rd 160. Turn right and travel .4 miles to the west trailhead of Owl Mt Jeep Trail. The trail emerges onto Rd 220 6.8 miles later and keeps turning right onto Rd 215 and then Kerry Creek Rd 150. Return on Kerry Creek to the junction with Little Boulder Creek Rd.



History:

The Talisman Mine is a little over a mile northeast of the Owl Mt trail. It was discovered by 1901 and worked in 1915- 1915 and 1946-1950 producing copper, iron, zinc and lead along with many other minerals. A tramway reached from the mine down almost 2000 feet to the town of Laurier on the Kettle River below. Recent mineral exploration has renewed interest in the mine with the discovery of a large magnetic ore body nearby.



Cautions:

Weather may change suddenly. Be prepared. There may be limbs, trees and rocks that block the roadway. Carry axe or saw and shovel.
